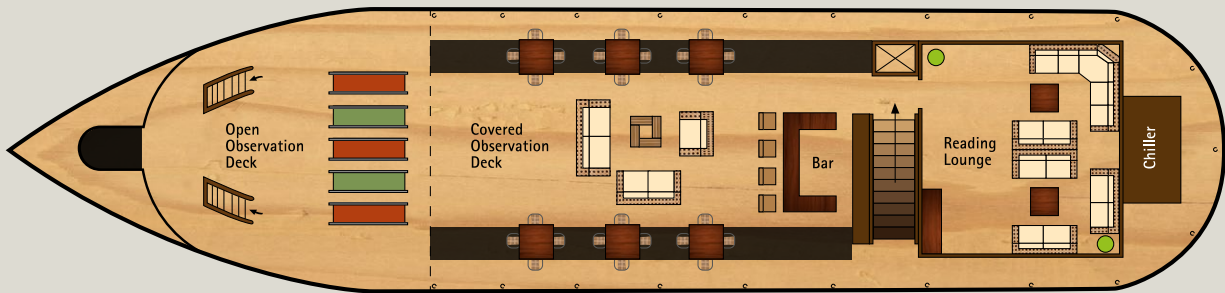

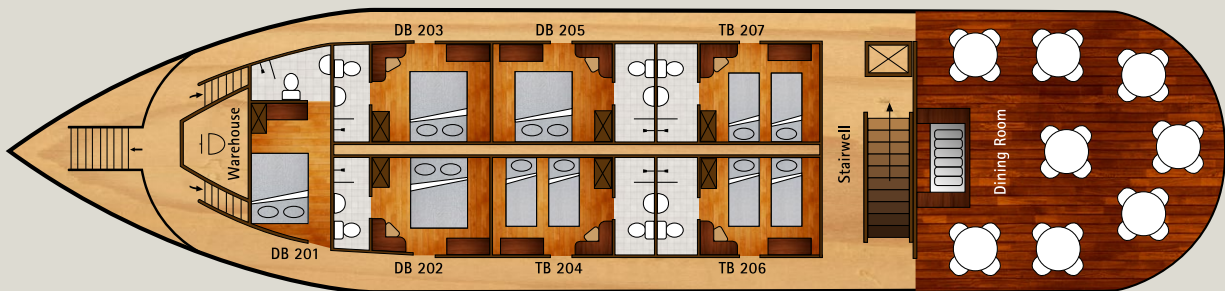

Deck plan

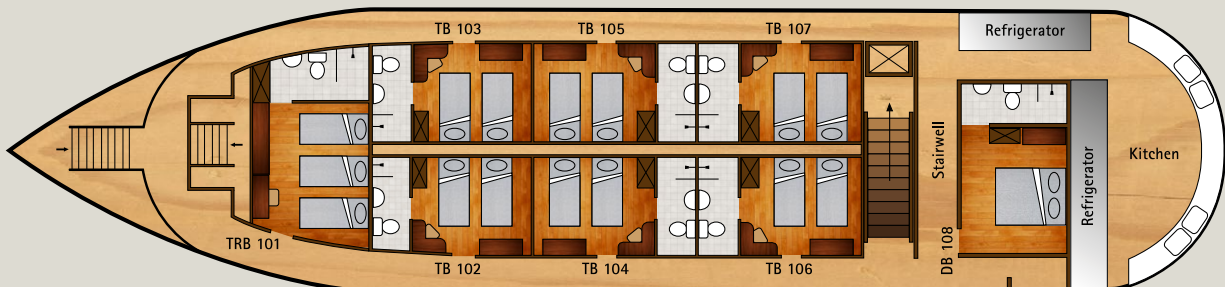
Observation deck
